

## Vocabulary Chart-2

### (How to prevent the spread of Covid-19)



outbreak(n.)	A time when a disease suddenly begins
Ex: The outbreak of Covid-19 changes the way we live.	
prevent (V.)	To stop something
Ex: Let's work together to prevent the spread of Covid-19.	
sanitizer(n.)	the thing we can use to kill germs , bacteria or virus
Ex: Wash your hands with sanitizers to prevent the spread of Covid-19	
alcohol-based (adj.)	with alcohol inside
Ex: Alcohol-based hand sanitizers are useful to kill the viruses.	
available(adj)	Able to be used
Ex: Mom has a hand sanitizer available all the time in her bag.	
disinfect(v.)	To clean something with sanitizers to kill bacteria that cause diseases
Ex: The students in our school disinfect their desks and chairs twice a week.	
avoid(v.)	To stay away from something
Ex: My family avoid going to public places with lots of people because of Covid-19.	
contact(N.V.)	Get in touch with or get close to
Ex: It's important to avoid close contact during the outbreak of Covid-19.	
Social distance(n.) Social distancing	The practice of keeping away from other people to prevent the spread of a disease
Ex. In public places, keep social distance.	
temperature check(n.)	Before you go into any public places, you need to have a temperature check.
preventive measures(n.)	Wearing a face mask and washing our hands whenever needed are common preventive measures for infectious diseases.
quarantine(n)	People coming from places with many Covid-19 cases need to be in quarantine for 14 days before they are free to go around.
