"Today I have nothing but dismal and depressing news to report. Our many Jewish friends and acquaintances are being taken away in droves.

A BRUTAL REFLECTION OF THE HOLOCAUST

'Shoah' Is the Hebrew word for 'catastrophe', which in English the word 'holocaust' is used in place for catastrophe. Anne's Diary is filled with her daily teenage life, however, it also paints the severe persecution that Jews faced during WWII.



761 DAYS

Anne and her family spent 761 days in hiding, and her diary includes an immense amount of detail of what she and her family did in hiding. These large amount of details help readers paint a greater picture of how Jews spent their time in hiding.



JEWS IN HIDING

Throughout Anne's journal entries, she mentions other Jews being arrested by the Gestapo, and sent to concentration camps. This helps emphasize the amount of Jews that went into hiding in the Netherlands during WWII. Scholars estimate that around 330,000 Jews went into hiding in the Netherlands during WWII.

2 HET ACHTERHUIS: THE SECRET ANNEX

Anne rewrote her a significant portion of her diary from 20, May,1944, and named it 'Het Achterhuis'. Adjustments were made, such as, more vivid descriptions of particularly events (bombings), content omitted(sex, sexuality, sexual identity).

3 CREATIVITY & IMAGINATION

Anne's diary included a wide variety of imaginary characters. These characters include; Kitty, Pop, Phien, Conny, Lou, Marjan, Jettje, Emmy. Out of these fictional characters Anne specifically addresses Kitty, with the following; 'Dear Kitty', 'My darling Kitty', and ' Dearest Kitty'.

"At three o'clock (Hello had left but was supposed to come back later), the doorbell rang. I didn't hear it, since I was out on the balcony, lazily reading in the sun. A little while later Margot appeared in the kitchen doorway looking very agitated. "Father has received a call-up notice from the SS," she whispered. "Mother has gone to see Mr. van Daan" (Mr. van Daan is Father's business partner and a good friend.) I was stunned. A call-up: everyone knows what that means. Visions of concentration camps and lonely cells raced through my head. How could we let Father go to such a fate? "Of course he's not going." declared Margot as we waited for Mother in the living room. "Mother's gone to Mr. van Daan to ask whether we can move to our hiding place tomorrow. The van Daans are going with us. There will be seven of us altogether." Silence. We couldn't speak. The thought of Father off visiting someone in the Jewish Hospital and completely unaware of what was happening, the long wait for Mother, the heat, the suspense - all this reduced us to silence.

Diaries From WWII

Zygmunt Klukowski, **Polish Doctor** October 21, 1942

From early morning until late at night we witnessed indescribable events. Armed SS soldiers, gendarmes, and "blue police" ran through the city looking for Jews. Jews were assembled in the marketplace. The Jews were taken from their houses, barns, cellars, attics, and other hiding places. Pistol and gun shots were heard throughout the entire day. Sometimes hand grenades were thrown into the cellars. Jews were beaten and nicked; it made no difference whether they were men, women, or small children.All Jews will be shot. Between 400 and 500 have been killed. Poles were forced to begin digging graves in the Jewish cemetery. From information I received approximately 2,000 people are in biding. The arrested mus were loaded into a train at the On January 20, 1942, 15 senior Nazi officials held a conference to discuss the implementation of a "Fina Solution" to obliterate the Jewish people. It took an nine months for the genocide to reach the sleepy to of Szczebrzeszyn in southeast Poland. The above entry was written by Zygmunt Klukowski, the chief physician of Szczebrzeszyn's small hospital. Kluko was an enthusiastic diarist and noted everything th occurred in his village during the Nazi occupation. took a great risk in doing so, knowing that the disco of his chronicle would have marked him for death.

This particularly harrowing entry documents the spe and ferocity with which Jews were rounded up in thousands of villages and towns throughout Eastern Europe. The following day, Klukewski noted that the German SS had already left the village, leaving the
