


WE MADE IT (TW STUDENTS)

FUN FACTS ABOUT THEM

A single pangolin can eat up to 70 million insects in a year. Pangolins are generally solitary, nocturnal animals known to have elusive behavioral patterns. Therefore, sightings of the Taiwanese pangolin in the wild are extremely rare, making it difficult for data to be collected. Pangolins are the only mammals with scales.

Previous Range

Including all the foothills and mesas on the island



Current Range

They are more common in broadleaf or secondary forests. About 2000 m should be the upper limit of the distribution altitude of pangolins.









