	In 1997 the first students gained the university entrance degree (German Abitur), in 2009 Chinese language was introduced as a new subject. In 2001 and 2018 the school extended the building to accommodate more students.
School environment	Eilpe was originally a separate city, but since 1876 it is part of the city of Hagen in North Rhine-Westphalia, located in the Western part of Germany. Eilpe has around 12.000 citizens (Hagen has 188.000 in total) and is rich in history and culture.
